Rockingham Castle

Rockingham Castle was built on the instruction of William the Conqueror in the 11th century shortly after the Norman Invasion of Britain. The castle continued to evolve and within three decades, William II replaced it with a stone castle. This site has a long history because of its position on elevated ground, providing a clear view of the Welland Valley and a strong defensive location.

It has been continuously occupied for nearly 1,000 years by the Watson family since it was relinquished as a Royal Castle. The garden has seventeenth century terraces, huge yew hedges, a nineteenth century woodland garden, a circular rose garden and a 1960's wild garden. The castle has also been used for many TV productions and featured in the film Top Secret!, which starred Val Kilmer.


At 2 miles, the Bruntingthorpe Aerodrome runway is the longest in Europe. The Americans used it as a heavy bomber base from 1957 to 1982. Now privately owned, it is used for the testing and storage of vehicles. A collection of cold war planes are fired up for "fast taxi runs" once a year. An over exuberant RAF lightning did lift off briefly in 2009, much to the disapproval of the CAA. It landed safely before the end of the runway.


